

2018 Summary of Watercraft Inspections at the four public landings in Fifty lakes.

Data was collected from the Minnesota DNR website for AIS Inspections conducted in 2018.

The summary includes the days of the week and the number of watercraft that used that landing each day. It also includes the number of days an AIS inspector was at each landing.

Additional information:

1. AIS inspectors were assigned to the four public landings a total of 104 days from May through September 2018.
2. 41 of those days were at the East Fox Lake landing and were funded by Crow Wing County from funds the county received from the state. The funds from the state were from a bill that was passed by the Minnesota Legislature.
3. The remaining inspector hours were funded by support received from FLPOA members and the Fifty Lakes Fireman's Relief Association. These funds supported AIS inspectors at the Eagle, Kego and Mitchell Lake landings.
4. An inspectors day was 8 hours.
