Park update

This is a private park for exclusive-use by members and their guests who have met the criteria below. (dues paid/waivers signed). Road access is 2783 Keats Ave NW. The beautiful evergreen trees were planted by the Lake Association about 20 years ago.

In the next few weeks, you'll be seeing a new dock, picnic tables, a swing set, horseshoe pit, BBQ grill, fire ring, and more! The road and lower area are being treated for mosquitos weekly! All this is being made possible by Jim & Mary! It's up to us to maintain, keep clean, and ENJOY this beautiful property. We have recycling bins, but ask you dispose of your own trash and pick up dog droppings.

We encourage parking at the entrance gate and taking a nature walk, but feel free to drive down. For now, Please do not drive on the grass!

NO DUES/NO WAIVER....NO PARK!

As a reminder, only those current with dues and have signed waivers on file are allowed to use the new Park. This is a provision of our lease and required by our insurance company! Attached to this newsletter is a copy of the waiver that must be signed by you and your guests and emailed to (timwaldschmidt3@gmail.com) or mailed to Tim at 2309 Kimball Ave NW, Annandale, MN 55302, before entering the property. Please email or text Tim at 612-325-8042 with any questions, comments or concerns. He will give you the code for gate after signed waivers received. Note: Please lock the gate and scramble numbers each time you enter/exit via the road. You will also be able to reserve the Park for a reunion, graduation, or family gathering. If that date is open, the BBQ grill, picnic tables, and game area will be for your use. The beach and dock are always open to other members. Cannot reserve during holidays such as 4th of July, Labor Day weekend, etc. \$150 refundable deposit required.

Aquatic Invasive Species

Free AIS Decontamination Station

We encourage everyone to take advantage of this free service to have your boats and watercraft cleared of all Aquatic Invasive Species before entering the lake:

- Location: Anchor Dock and Lift Storage Facility 240 Popular Ave Annandale
- Monday Thursday: 9am to 5pm
- Friday Sunday: 7am to 7pm
- Small boats take about 10 minutes; larger vessels 20-30 minutes

Eurasian Water Milfoil

As discussed at our Annual Meeting, we will again be treating the lake for Eurasian Water Milfoil. We do not yet know what parts of the lake will be treated as we are still awaiting the results of the AIS survey. That information will be shared as soon as it becomes available.

Zebra Mussel Monitoring

Zebra mussels have been found in nearby lakes. However, we are happy to report that **NO zebra mussels** have been found in Granite Lake! On Granite Lake, many of you have seen the Zebra Mussel monitoring kits that were installed on some of your docks. Many thanks to Scott and Gretchen Quiggle who will again be installing the kits on the same docks and checking them every 2-3 weeks all summer. Early detection of zebra mussels is extremely important if we are to have a chance to address an issue in our lake. Therefore, it is critical that we stay vigilant on this and we plan to monitor again next summer.

It is important to follow these steps to prevent the spread of zebra mussels and other invasive species to Granite Lake.

- If you buy a used dock, lift, or boat you must check it for zebra mussels and Eurasian Water Milfoil before
 putting it in Granite Lake. The DNR also specifies:
 - Spraying the used equipment with high-pressure water;
 - Rinsing with hot water (120 degrees for two minutes, or 140 degrees for 10 seconds); or
 - Drying the equipment for at least five days (note that "best current science" suggests 21-29 days dry).
