

**xLAKE ALEXANDER LAKE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT  
ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING  
SATURDAY, August 14, 2021  
Chairman Dr. Bill Faber, Ron Wieber, Chuck Schiemo, John Piper, Mike Becker**

Chairman Dr. Bill Faber called the meeting to order at 10:27 A.M. with approximately 51 members in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was recited.

**Secretary's Report:**

A motion was made by Mike Simonet, seconded by Mike Faust, to approve the minutes of the 2019 Annual LALID Meeting as printed and mailed to all property owners. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report:**

Treasurer Ron Wieber reported that the current checking account balance as of July 23, 2021, was \$34,653.61, In addition, the LALID has a savings account balance of \$77,580.18, and the LALID also holds a 36 month CD in the amount of \$108,516.54 that is due in February 2022.

The projected ending checking account balance for the fiscal year on December 31, 2021 is \$18,590.67

A motion was made by Matt Skjonsby, seconded by Jodi Wieczorek, to approve the Treasurer's Report. Motion carried.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**Lake Restoration and Aquatic Invasive Vegetation Treatment for 2019:**

**Curlyleaf Pondweed:**

RMB Labs surveyed the lake for Curlyleaf Pondweed (CLP), and on May 17, 2021, Lake Restoration treated 20.5 acres of CPL (primarily around Andersons Bay) at the cost of \$21,822.

**Eurasian Water Milfoil:**

On July 24, 2021, RMB Labs were on the lake again, for the purpose of surveying areas of Eurasian Water Milfoil. The results are pending. Observations of milfoil topping out in areas around Greens Island are noted. Permits for treatment are granted in high traffic areas where docks and watercraft are numerous.

It was reported that the invasive EWM has been becoming a hybrid with the native Northern Milfoil. At the present, this hybrid has not yet been designated as an invasive plant. It is encouraged to take a sample of the plant if you are questioning its identity.

**Zebra Mussels:**

There is no satisfactory treatment for zebra mussels at this time. Copper sulfate is the most effective, but it is extremely toxic to native plants. The U OF M Aquatic Invasive Species Research Center is working on a biological treatment. Zebra mussels are most prominent in rocky substrate and around islands. Wearing water shoes is highly recommended.
