

RESOLUTION ORDERING FEASIBILITY STUDY OF THE 2018 LAKE SHAMINEAU
WATER LEVEL IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, Lake Shamineau is experiencing abnormal variances in water level which has led to erosion issues along the shoreline; and

WHEREAS, Morrison County has already authorized and enabled the Lake Shamineau Lake Improvements District; and


WHEREAS, the Board of said District would like to create a way to regulate lake levels and prevent future flooding and erosion; and


