## Shamineau-Crookneck Flood Protection

Morrison County has enacted a Flood Protection Ordinance for the benefit of residents on Lake Shamineau and Crookneck. The ordinance essentially relaxes the limits for grade and fill within the shore impact zone. The Ordinance will sunset on December 10, 2020.
